
# **Guerilla Marketing**



## What is Guerrilla Marketing?

Guerrilla Marketing is an advertising strategy that focuses on low-cost unconventional marketing tactics that yield maximum results.

The name is inspired by "guerrilla warfare", a form of irregular warfare using small tactic strategies - many of these tactics include ambushes, sabotage, raids and elements of surprise.

## **Core Questions to Consider**

- What is the key message you want to impart?
- Who is your audience?
- Where can you reach them?
- How can you creatively infiltrate their space?
- What device or action could you communicate with?
- What results do you want?

### **Key Message**

(translating your statement into a tangible object or action)

Who are you?
What do you do?
How do you do it?
Connect - contact or message info!

What action or object could sum this up and/or inspire your audience to seek more information?

(warfare tactics with a positive outcome)


- Resourceful limited time and money
